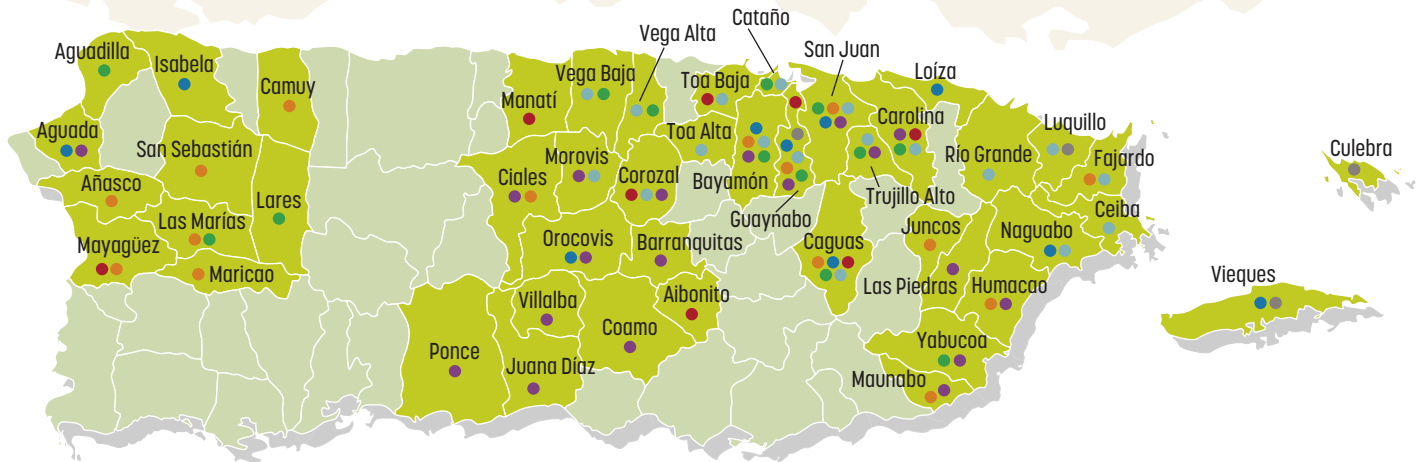

IMPACTED TOWNS

Hurricane Fiona made landfall in southwestern Puerto Rico on September 18, 2022. The following day, Banco de Alimentos de Puerto Rico began efforts to help deliver much needed emergency food boxes to populations in greatest need in the face of this atmospheric phenomenon. In collaboration with various organizations, donors and volunteers, we have reaffirmed our commitment to our mission during hunger awareness month.

SUPPORT FROM NEW YORK

On Friday, September 30, we were visited by Robert Rodriguez, Secretary of the State of New York, who announced in a press conference the support of Gov. Kathy Hochul for Puerto Rico. As part of the collaboration, we received 40.320 pounds of food and 4.032 pounds of water.
